Hair should be neat and properly up for class. It is just as important as a school or sport uniform. Having your hair in a bun is a part of ballet class etiquette.


It's easier than it looks and can be done quite quickly.

ALL classical classes require a bun.








#### KHSD style and colour for Acorns, Pre Primary, Primary, Grade 1 and Grade 2


This is the exam leotard for Grades 3, 4 & 5


